Again it is time for the annual von Rosenberg family reunion. We will meet, beginning about 10 a.m., Sunday, May 5, at Round Top (between La Grange and Brenham) where Cousin Daisy Fricke has again arranged for the VFW Hall, about a mile northeast on State Highway 237. Bring your lunch and drinks, though bottled beverages will be on sale.

Last year from as far as California and as near as Round Top, some 60 assembled. The oldest was 86; the youngest was 6 weeks!

This year we will elect officers for a two year term. Registration fees, to defray rent, postage, and other expenses, are \$1 per household. Copies of the translated letters telling of the emigration are still available at \$1 and the current mailing list is being reproduced for sale at cost (plus postage if so ordered). So much for business.

During the year deaths reported are those of Henry S. Thompson, Olga Scholz (author of our reunion prayer) and her brother Paul Scholz, and of Alma Tomlinson.

It is with great regret we learn of these. With Walter Wupperman, who suggested the reunions, and Martha Neerscheidt, who collected many of the early records, Alma Tomlinson shaped our present organization. Her perseverance and undaunted energy as historian made possible the printing of the history of the first three generations and the maintenance of interest in the annual reunions. May we continue what they so worthily began!
