von Rosenberg Y-DNA Surname Project

The purpose of the Rosenberg/Rosenburg Y-DNA project is to genetically define & identify the different families.

Y-DNA STR testing of the male Y-chromosome is a powerful tool for identifying genetically related men with a common ancestor on their patrilineal line. It can confidently support your membership in your own family & firmly separate you from other, non-related families. Y-DNA testing is highly successful in breaking down brick walls & debunking errors in paper genealogy.

Only males have a Y-chromosome, so only males can participate. The goal is to test at least 2 patrilineal line male descendants of every Rosenberg/Rosenburg family in the world.
